
In order to put the "fear of the wolf" into perspective, the authors of this book suggest reversing the roles!

- In his escape, he meets Maryvonne the cow, a crocodile, and a solenodon, who have come from distant lands. Maryvonne tries to convince Pierre that the Big Bad Man does not exist.
- What is blue, a bad advisor, and paralyzes and cuts off your legs? Fear!!! The Big Bad Man is nothing but fear.

A 4-page supplement on the most unusual and funny fears concludes the book.





A letter from her father tells her that a fairy has cast a spell on her and that she will not wake up for another 100 years.



Reversing the codes, here it is men, attracted by the smell of blood, who act as wild beasts.




MÉLODIE BLOO Mélody Bloo
