- A book that will please parents and children alike, for a shared reading in a good mood!



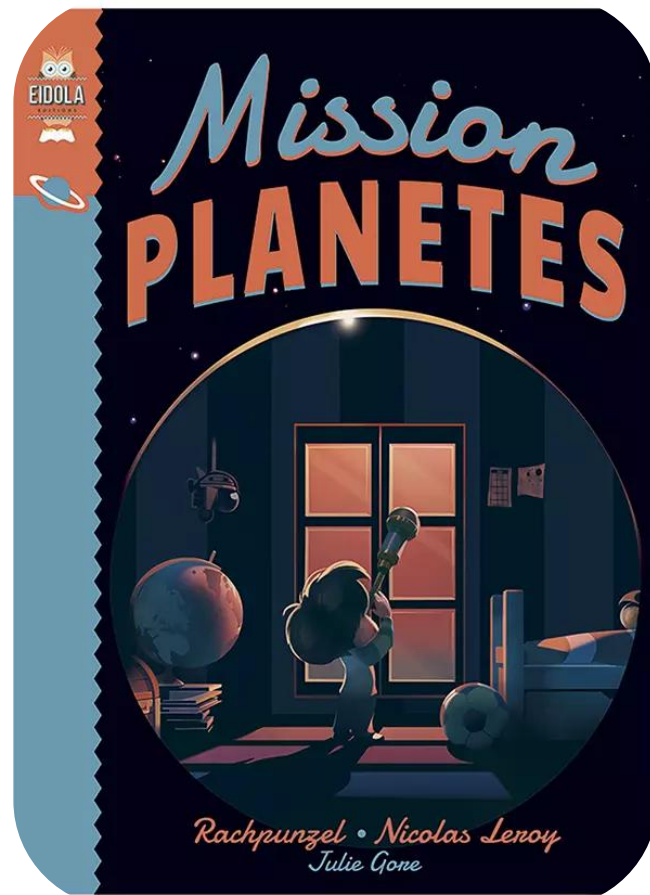

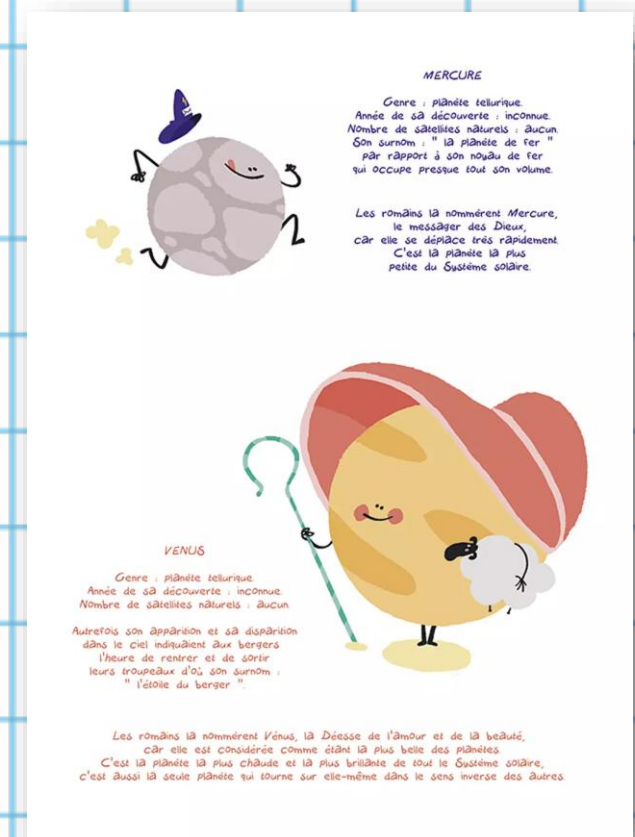
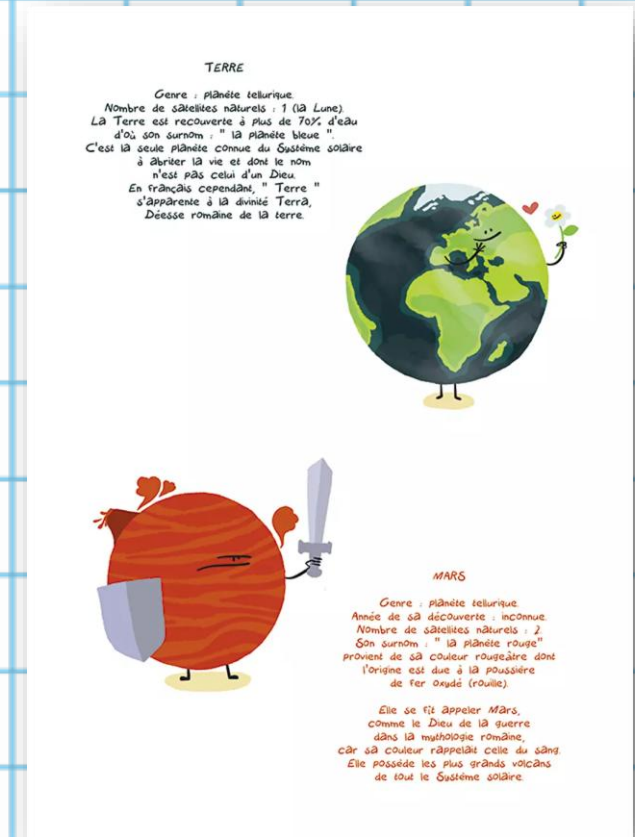

MISSION PLANETES Mission: Planets

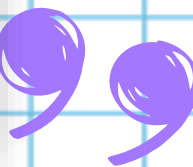

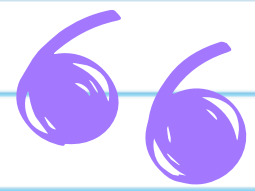

BONJOUR MADAME ! Hello Lady!

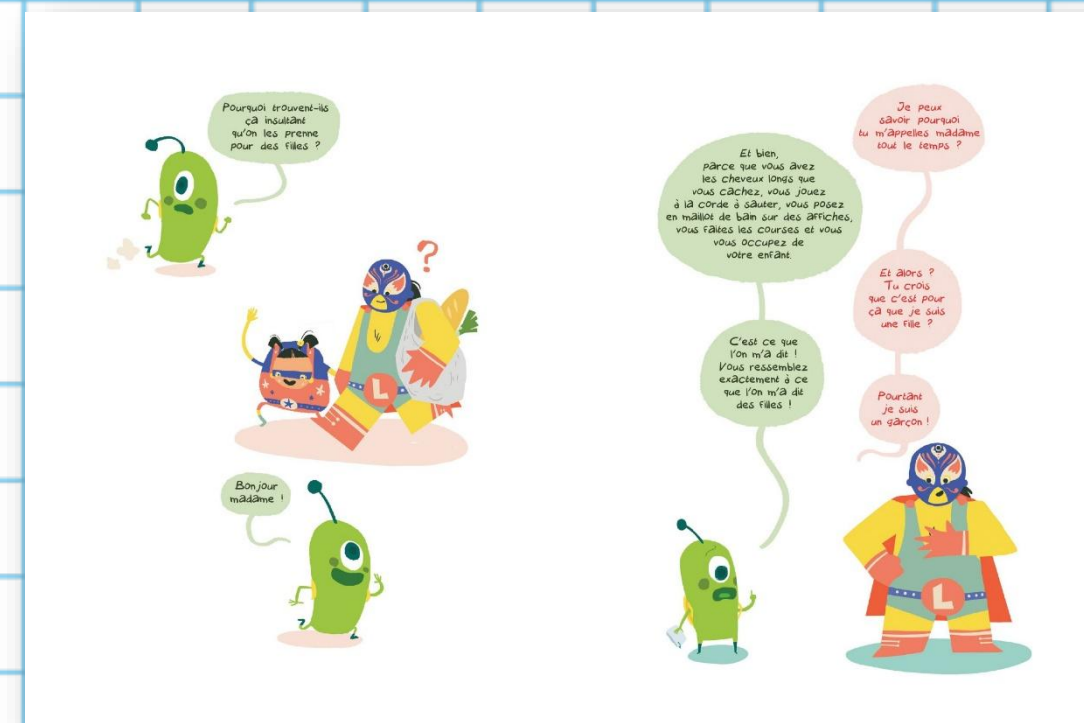
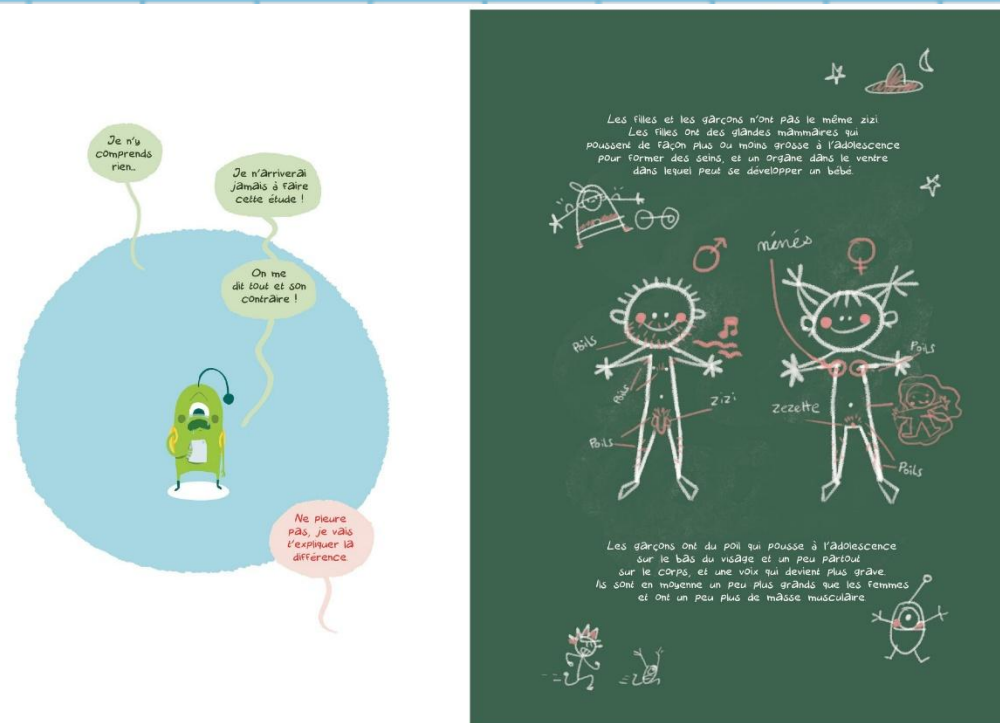

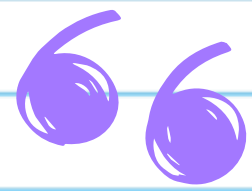
Two boards on the transformations of the body during adolescence complete the story.

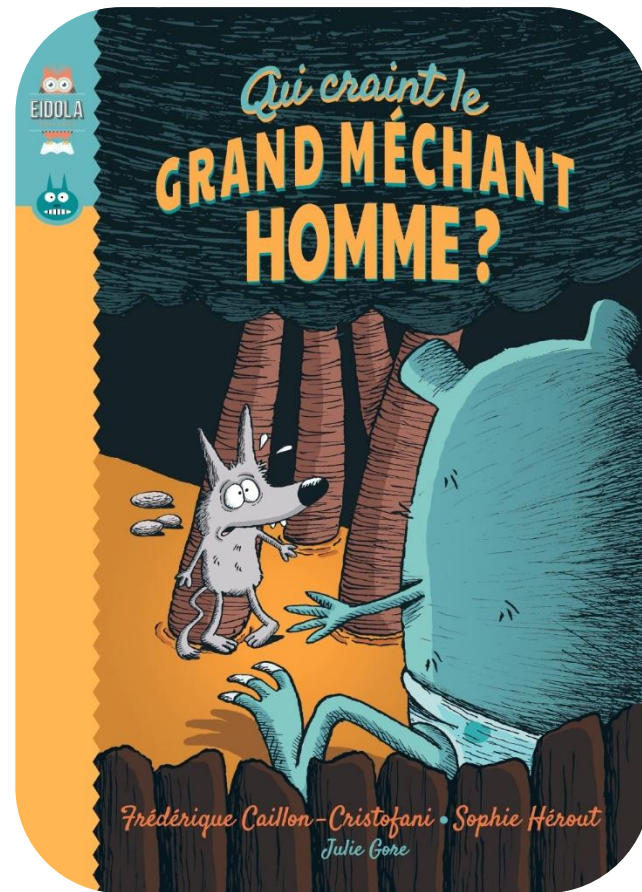

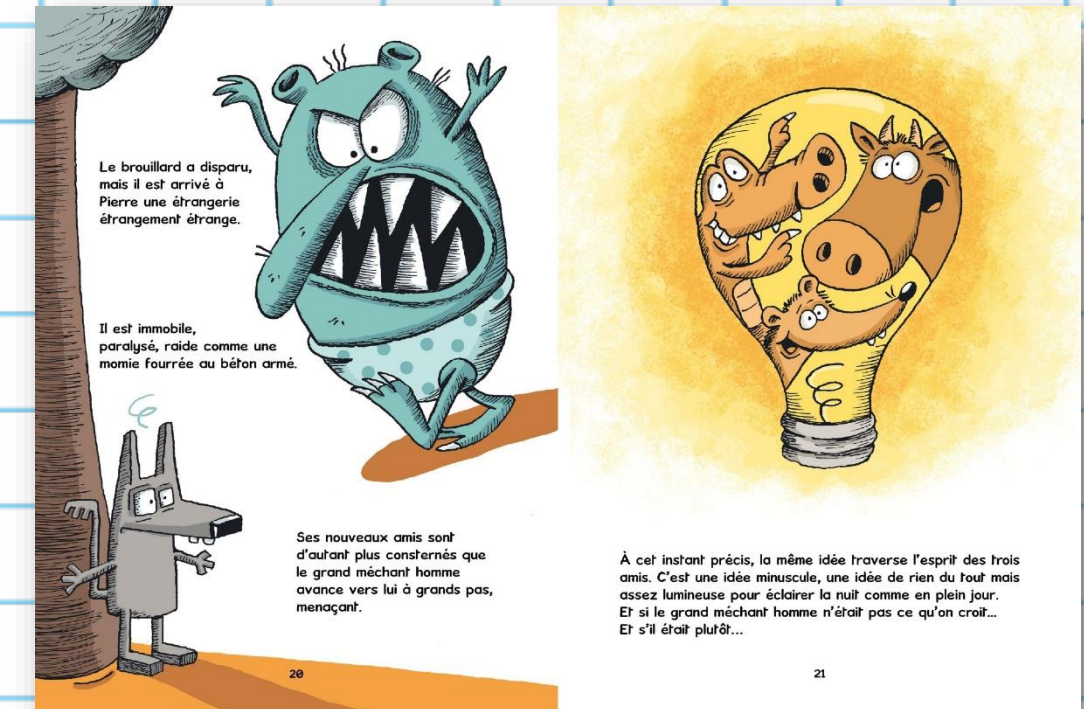
QUI CRAINT LE GRAND MÉCHANT HOMME? Who Fears the Big Bad Man?

In order to put the "fear of the wolf" into perspective, the authors of this book suggest reversing the roles!

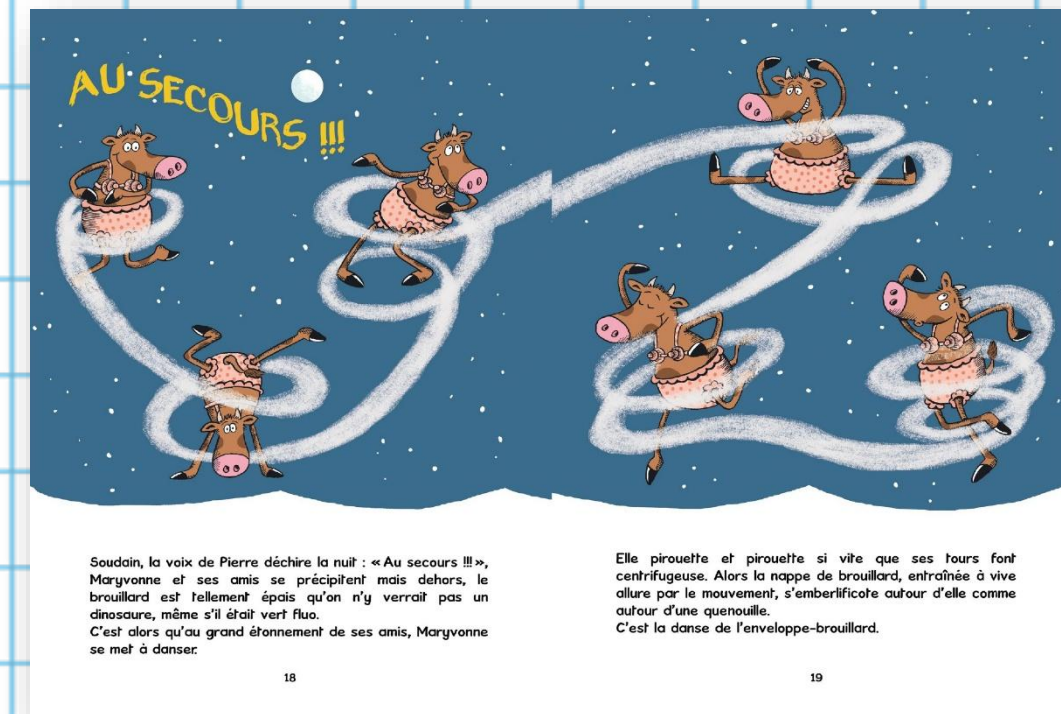
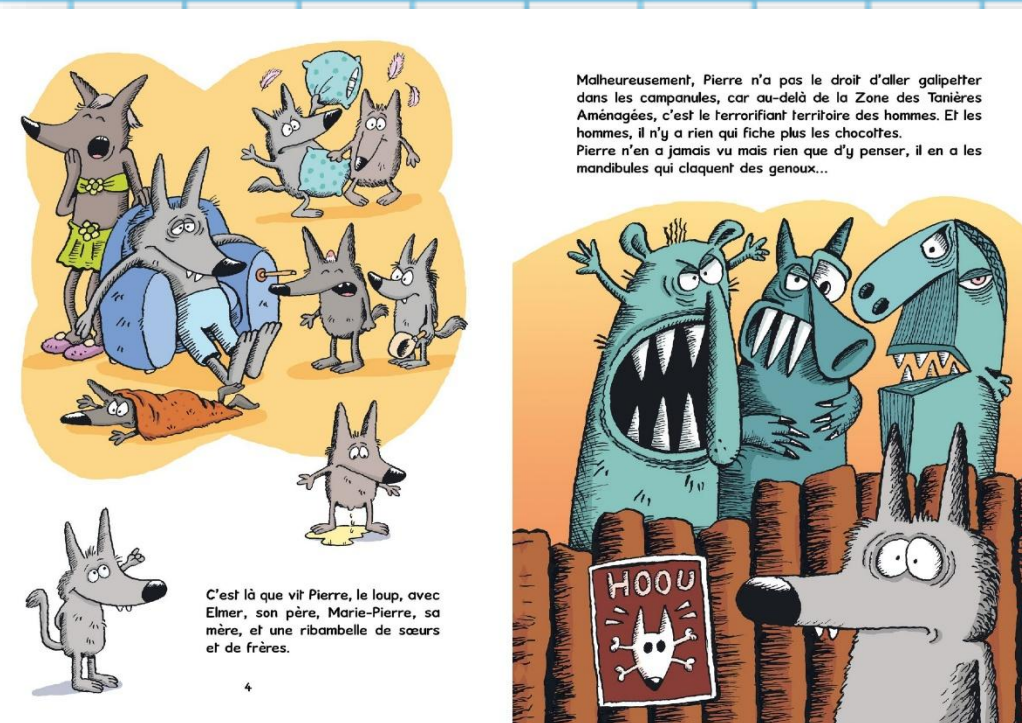

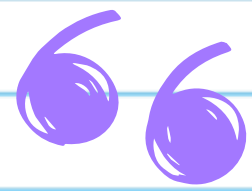

A 4-page supplement on the most unusual and funny fears concludes the book.



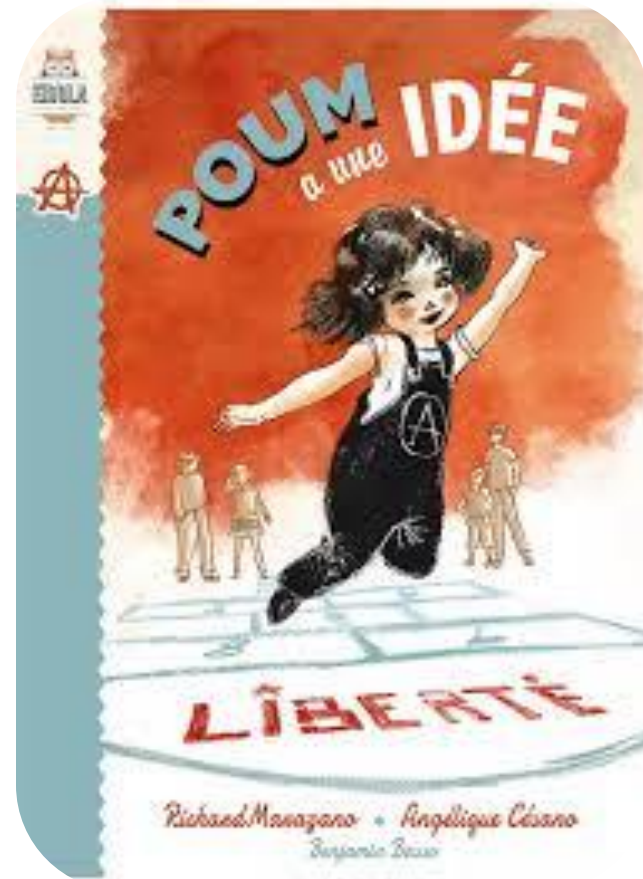

POUM A UNE IDÉE! Poum has an idea!

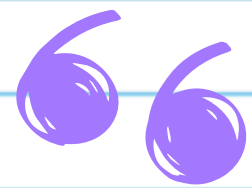

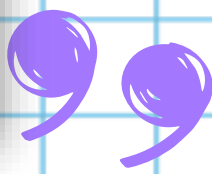
Mimo, the naughty little dinosaur, discovers a ferocious world in which he will live two funny adventures, inspired by paleontological excavations.

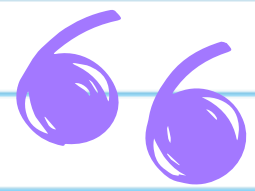
Isabelle Dethan's lively texts and Mazan's tasty drawings are very well documented on the fauna and flora of this period of prehistory, more than 100 million years ago!

Bilingual Edition : The texts are in French on white pages and English on dark pages.



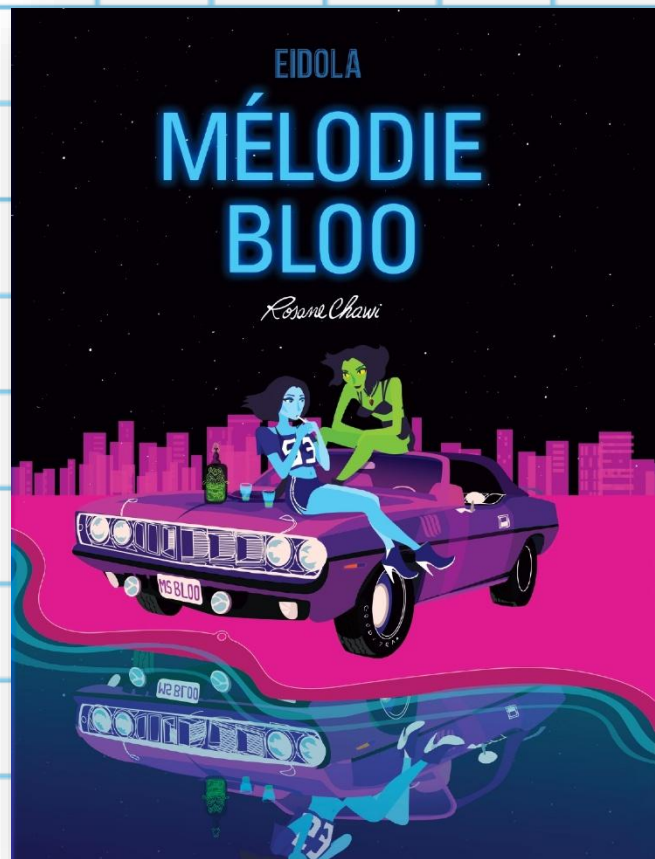

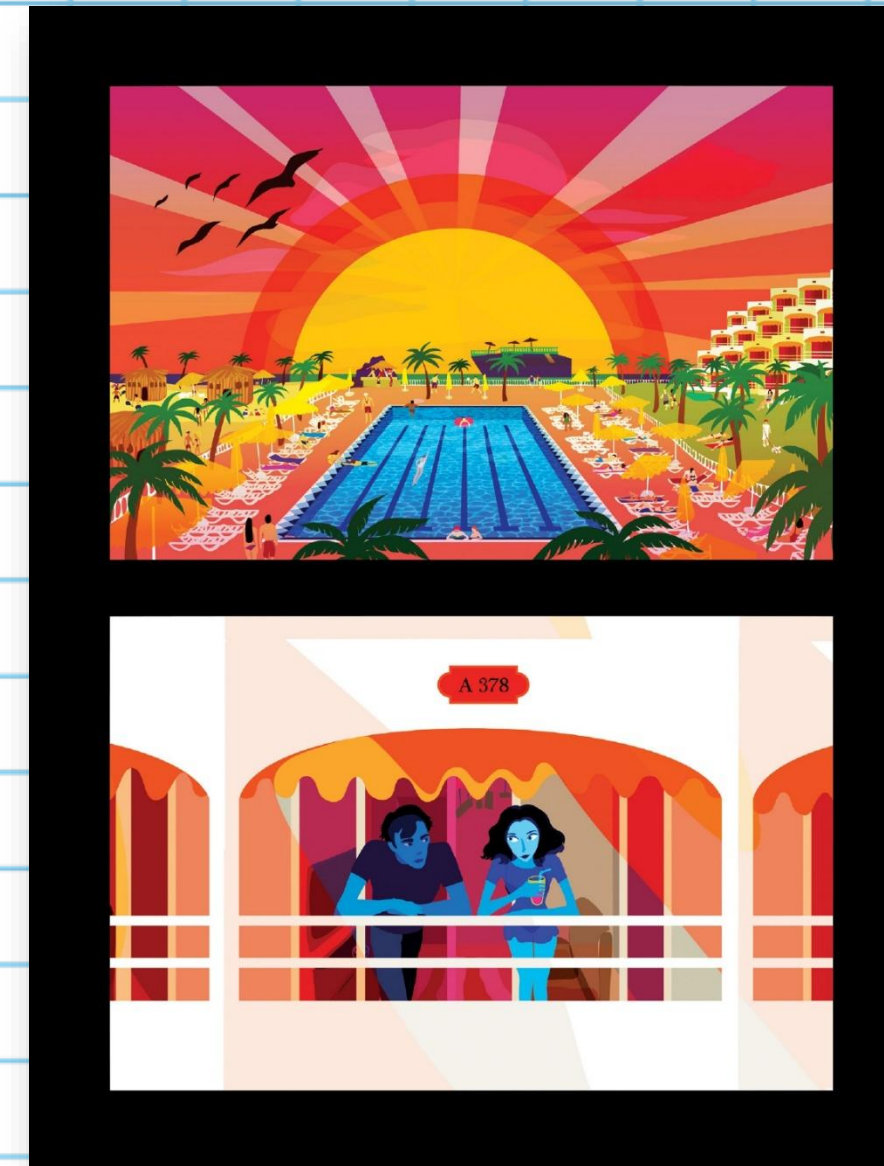

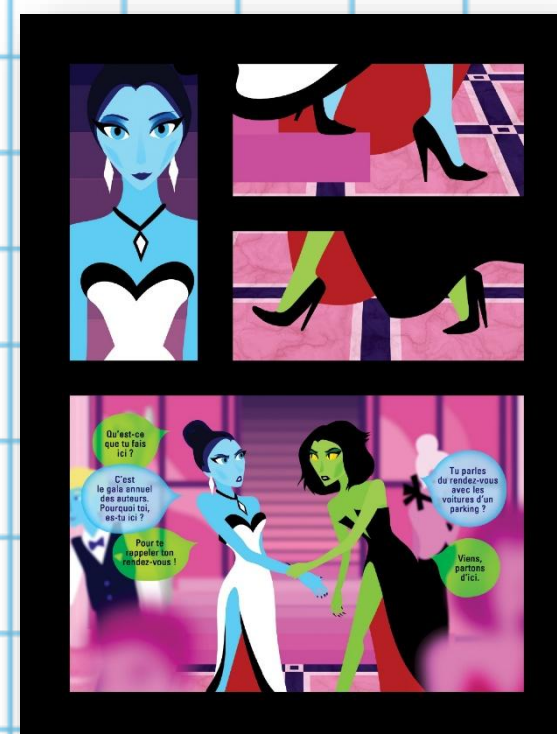
MÉLODIE BLOO Mélody Bloo
