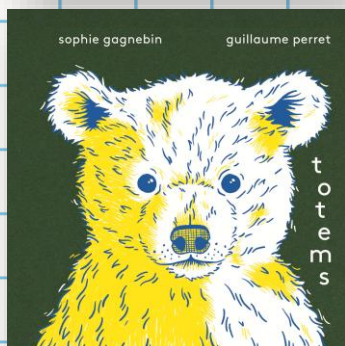
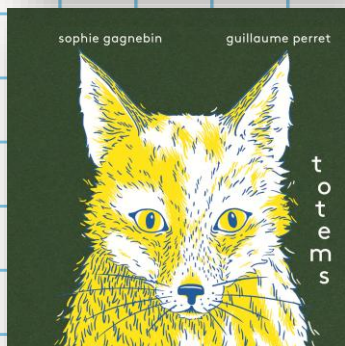

## TOTEMS Totems

Snapshots of a creative and free childhood - today a lynx, tomorrow a frog, sometimes a cherry tree, always a child!

Based on a series of children's portraits by photographer Guillaume Perret, illustrator Sophie Gagnebin has created Totems, a highly original children's picture book, a subtle celebration of the child's imagination and nature.

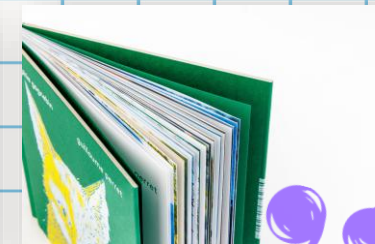
Words, photographs, and illustrations interact, exploring children's relationship with animals and plants, and seeking to awaken their natural sensitivity to the living.

Transparently on tracing paper, around the words, or directly on the photographs, the brightly colored illustrations allow the imagination to escape and create unexpected connections.

As a backdrop, the surrounding nature and domestic settings sketch out a narrative, marking the passage of time with photographic interludes of landscapes on a double-page spread.

- Totems accompanies children of all ages until bedtime, which it encourages them to delay in order to answer the call of the outdoors!

- 3 cover models printed in silkscreen.

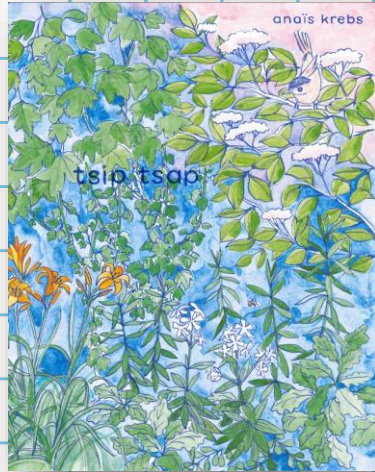

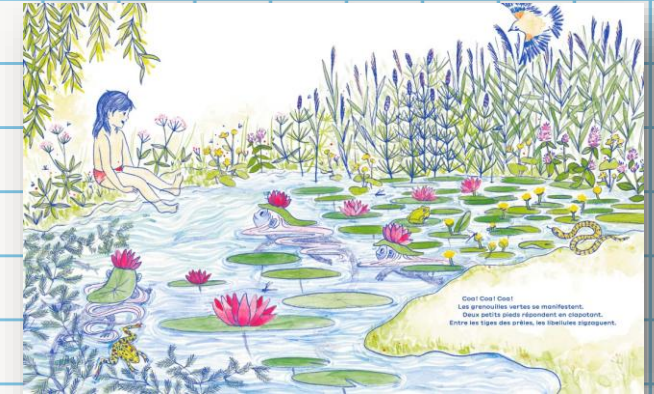
## TSIP TSAP Tsip Tsap

A passage opens up through lush vegetation, like an invitation to adventure. Intrigued, a child dares to take the plunge. Thus begins an escape amidst the flowers, plants, and animals, discovering a bustling natural world, inhabited by an unsuspected magic. From dawn to dusk, through the seasons and encounters, the child experiences a magical stroll, all senses awakened.

**Anaïs Krebs** is an artist from Switzerland, *Tsip tsap* is her very first picture book as an author and illustrator. *Tsip tsap* lifts a corner of the veil on her inner world, imbued with poetry and a touch of nostalgia, with Japanese and Nordic influences, and always close to nature.
