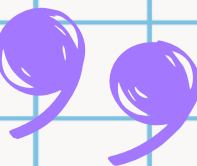
## UN SI LONG ETE such a long summer

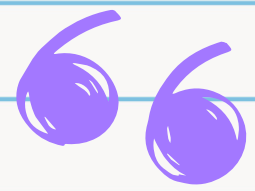

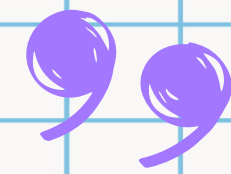

## COLIBRIS hummingbirds

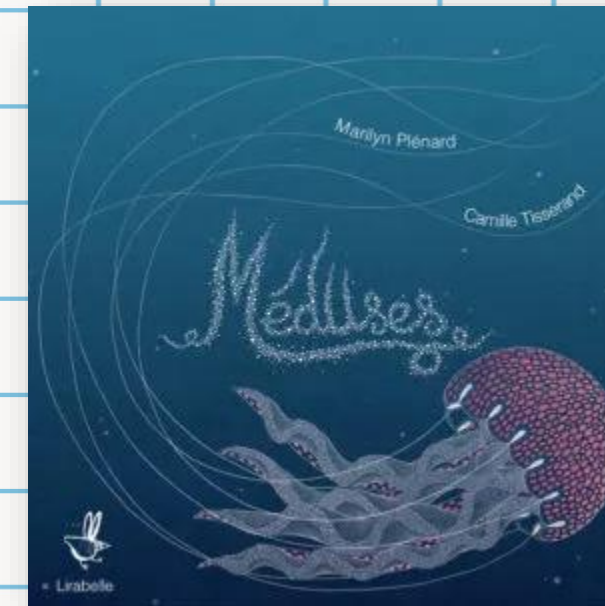
In the Americas live the smallest birds in the world.

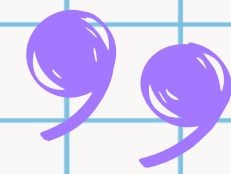
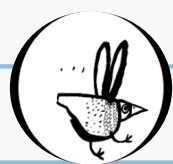
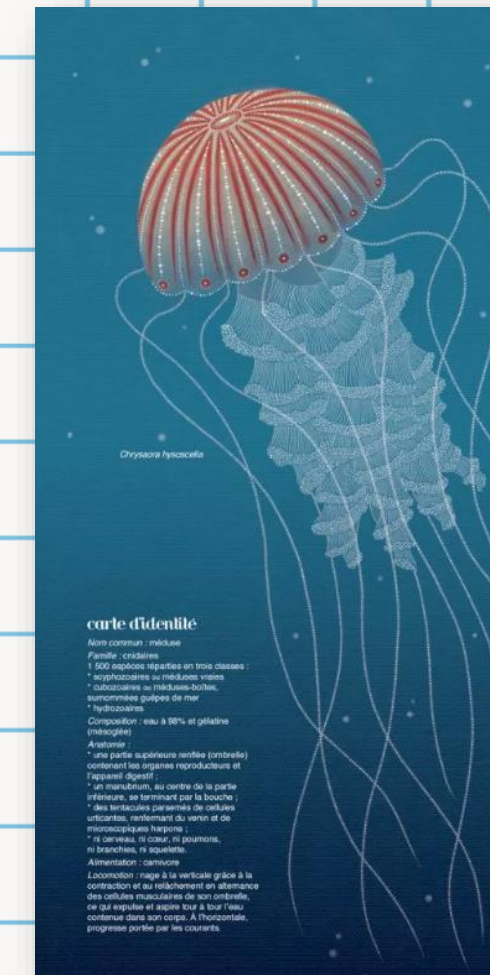
## MEDUSES jellyfish
