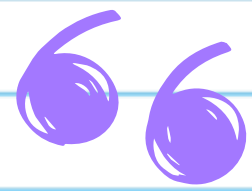

What if the most powerful weapon against gender stereotypes was an eight-year-old girl and her grandmother's magic library?

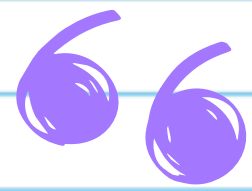

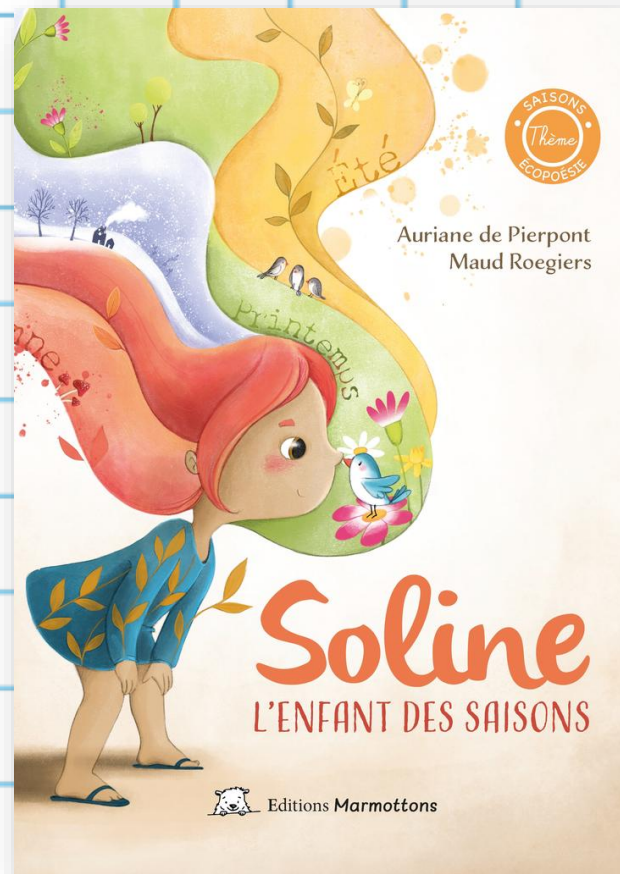

SOLINE L'ENFANT DES SAISONS Soline, Child Of The Seasons

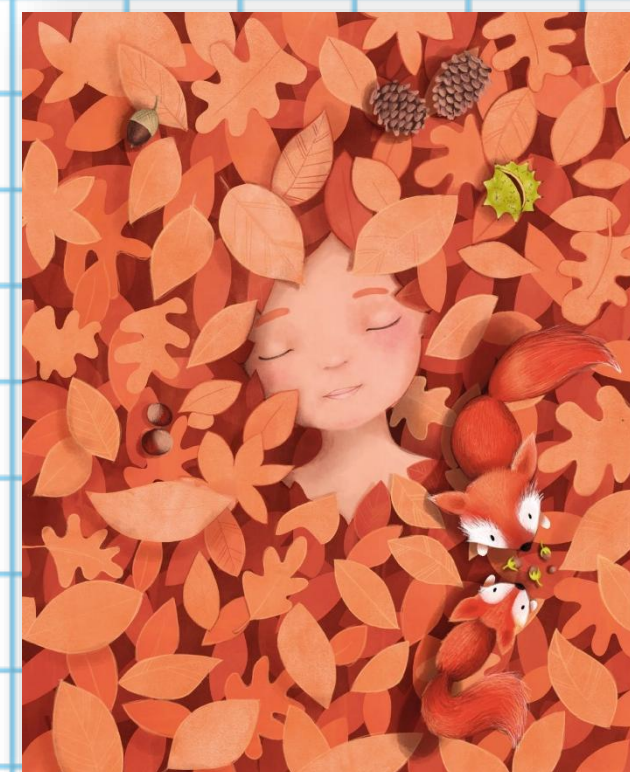
A story to raise children's awareness about protecting our planet.

Soline was born in summer, a little early, always eager. She talks to trees, listens to streams, and moves through the world as if she is part of it.

Season by season, she collects acorns in autumn, catches snowflakes on her tongue in winter, weaves daisy chains in spring, and chases butterflies in summer. But at seven years old, Soline begins to notice: hazelnut reserves are running low, winters are less snowy, bees are struggling to find flowers. The Earth is hurting.

And so Soline makes a choice: to shout it from the rooftops, to whisper encouragement to nature, and to invite everyone, children and adults alike to act together before the seasons are lost!

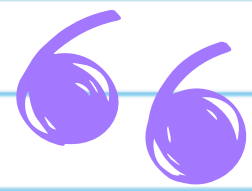

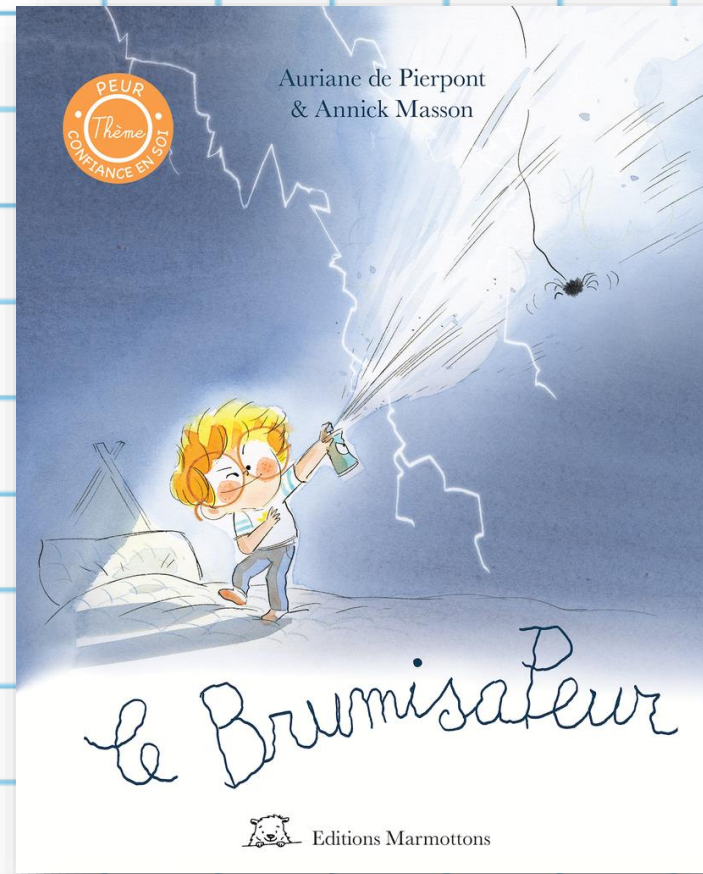

What if children could spray away their fears with a little magic... only to discover that the real courage was inside them all along?

Noah has always been afraid of everything. One day, his parents take him to see a mysterious doctor with oversized black glasses, who gives him a strange object: the "FearSpray," a magical fear-sprayer.

Every time Noah feels scared, he simply sprays: Pschitt! And little by little, his fears seem to disappear. Night monsters? Gone. Thunderstorms? Not so scary anymore. Public speaking? He shines. Tree climbing? He dares.

But when the FearSpray suddenly stops working, Noah is forced to face something even more important: maybe the magic was never in the object itself, but inside him. With kindness, humor, and imagination, he learns that fear is not an enemy, but an emotion we can understand, tame, and transform into strength.

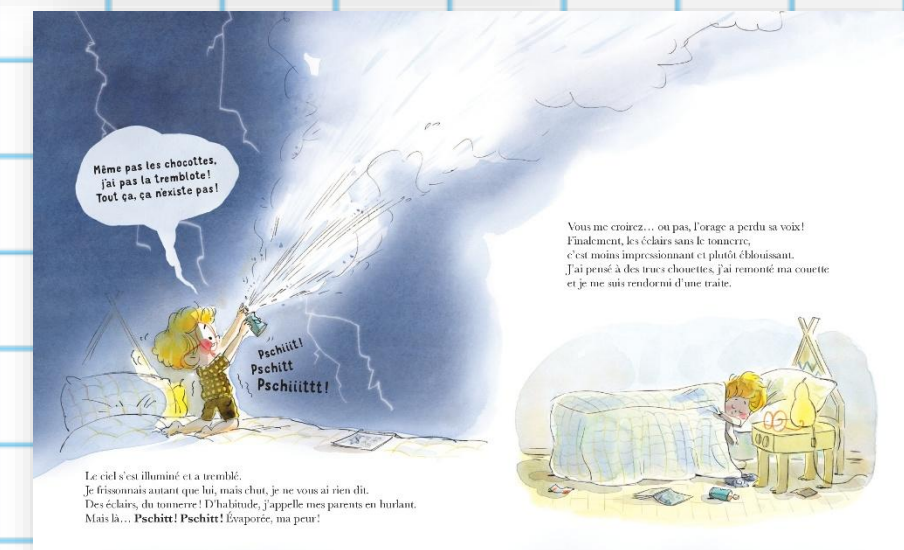

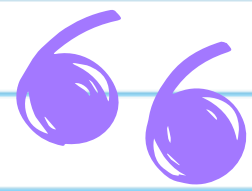

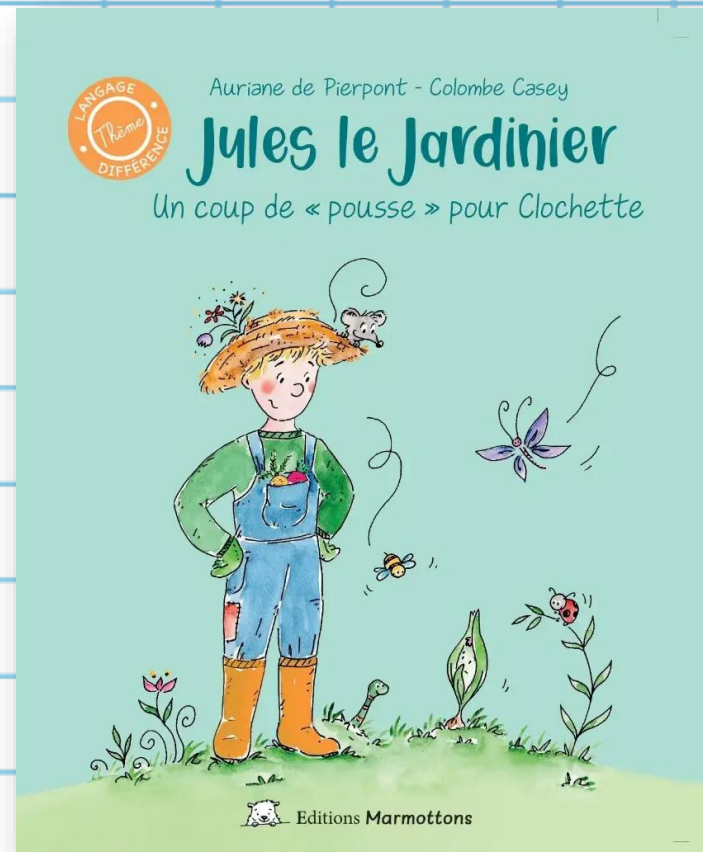

What if a flower that struggles to bloom could help children understand language difficulties, difference, and the power of kindness?

Jules is a cheerful gardener who adores flowers and takes loving care of his colorful garden. Every flower has its own personality, except little Clochette, a shy hyacinth whose petals remain closed.

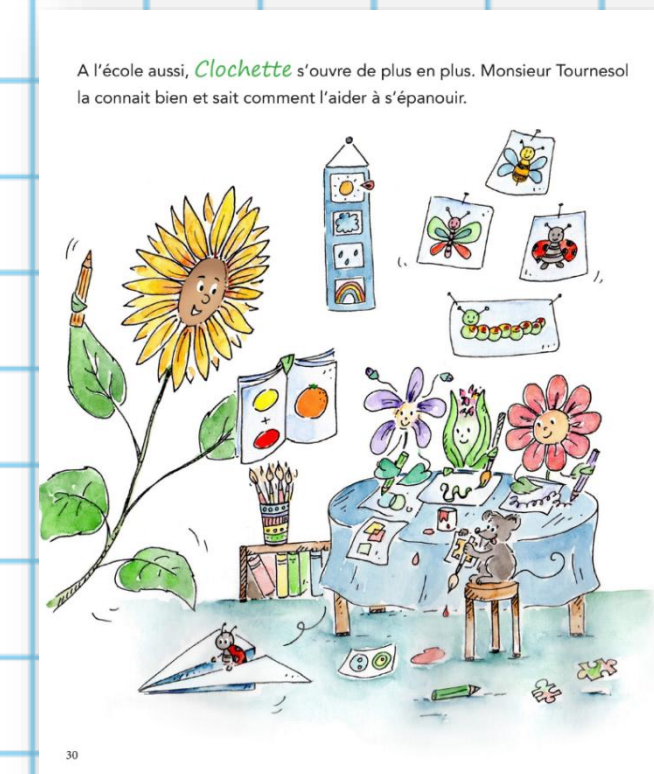
She barely speaks, struggles to communicate, and often hides behind her leaves.

Worried, Jules tries everything: sunshine, water, warmth, and care. But nothing seems to help.

Guided by Doctor Botanicus and Papote, the specialist in the "language of flowers," Jules and the other flowers begin to understand that Clochette does not need fixing, she needs time, adapted support, encouragement, and above all, people who truly listen. Together, they learn how to communicate differently: speaking slowly, using gestures and images, giving her time to respond, encouraging every small success, and valuing her strengths rather than focusing on her struggles. Little by little, Clochette starts to bloom.

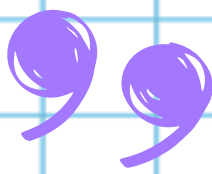
At school and in the garden, she gains confidence, finds her place, and reveals her own talents. She is not a flower that blooms late, she is simply a flower that blooms in her own way!

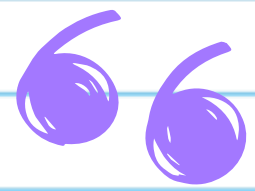

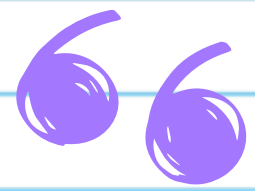
MELI-MELO CHEZ JULIETTE ET LEO A Hodgepodge at Juliette and Leo's

- Through this playful role reversal, children gain a fresh perspective on their parents' daily challenges, while parents are invited to reflect on their own behaviors and communication styles.

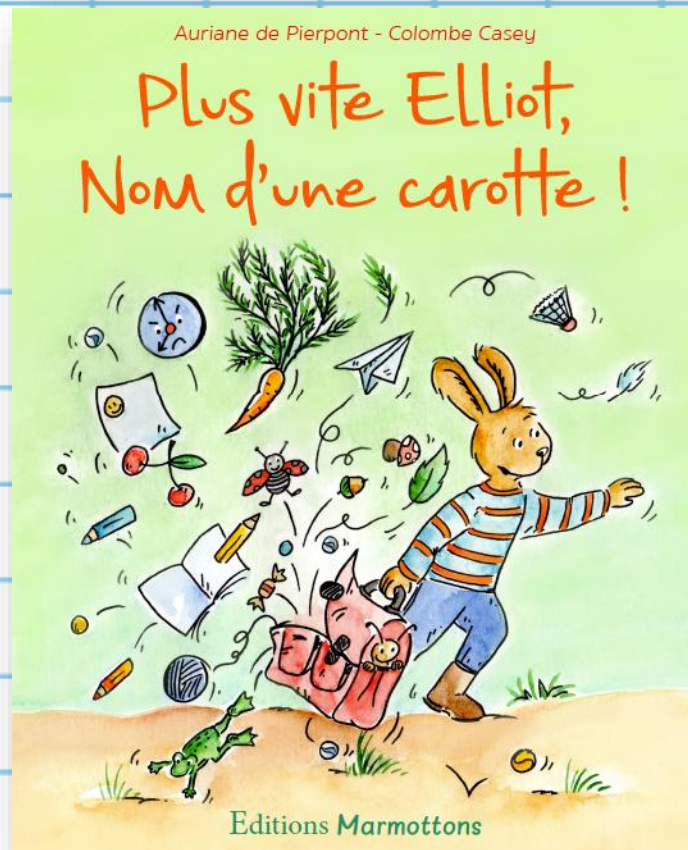

"Hop, hop, hop ! Faster, Elliot, for crying out loud !" is what he hears all day long.

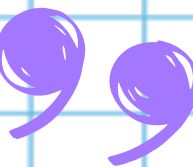
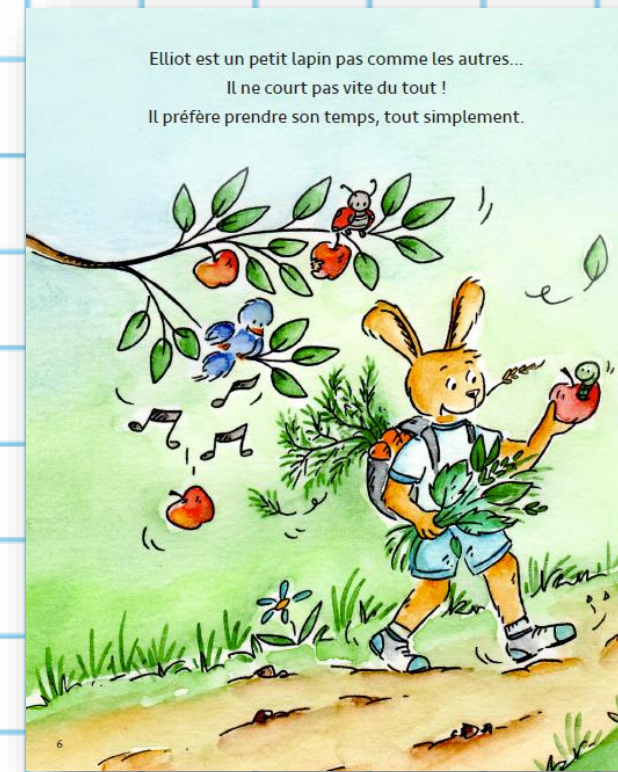

Zoé takes readers on a journey through her world of bubbles. She describes her world through her eyes, her emotions and the sensitivity of her heart, body and mind.

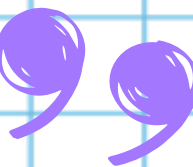
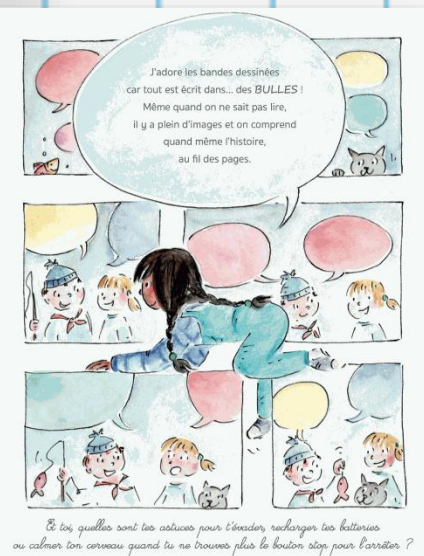

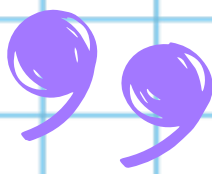
ETINCELLE Spark

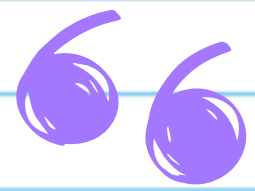
There is a talent in everyone. Spark doesn't know how to climb trees and growls in a strange way. So what is her talent? What if the answer were hidden in her thousand questions?

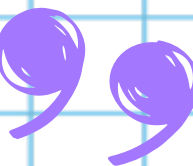
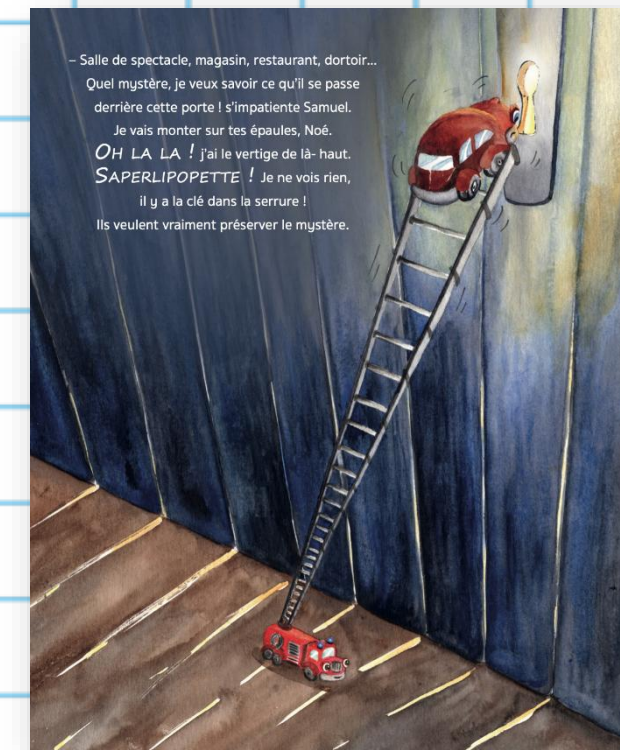
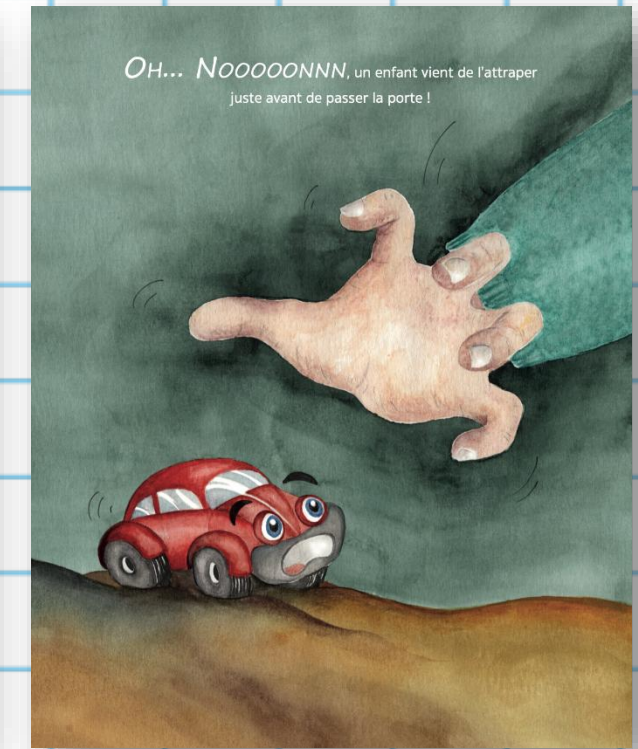
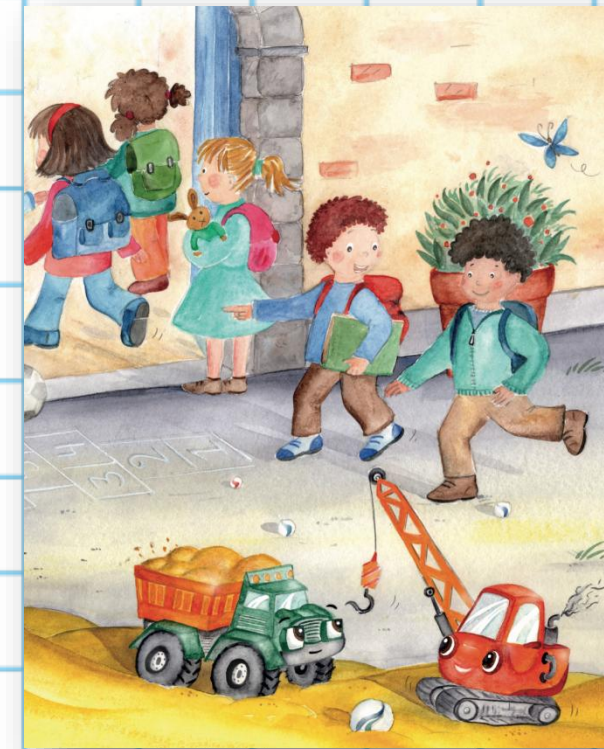
MYSTERE EN CLASSE A Classroom Mystery
